REMEMBERING Lilliane Shuman 1930-2019

Lilliane Shuman, active in the AAUW Palm Springs Branch for many years passed away on March 30, 2019. She served as President of the Branch from 2004-2006 and was Chair of the Tech Trek Fundraising Committee for 15 yeas. Under her leadership, the branch was able to send over 100 7th grade girls Coachella Valley girls to AAUW STEM Camp. Lilliane served as the first Palm Springs Branch Tech Trek Treasurer training a successor four years ago.

Lilliane was born in in Belgium. She and her parents and sister escaped to unoccupied France in 1940. They were separated when only her father could get passage to New York. Lilliane, her sister and mother ended up back in Antwerp and then Poland before fleeing to Cuba. Others in her family perished in concentration camps. Lilliane and her family were reunited with her father in New York in 1945.

Lilliane's college education was interrupted when she married a few years later and began having children. She worked for many years as a manager for Saks Fifth Avenue in Palm Springs but longed for a college degree. In 1997, at the age of 67, Lilliane returned to college and - like many AAUW'ers - obtained her bachelors degree from UCSB. Upon graduating college, the first thing Lilliane did was what she always dreamed of doing: she joined AAUW.

Lilliane was warm and affectionate. She gave generously of her time, talent and



resources ensuring the viability of our Tech Trek Program as it is today. We are so grateful and remember Lilliane with fondness and admiration.


A Program of AAUW Alumni Club Palm Springs Branch


